**Poster Guidelines:**

1. Poster dimensions should be less than 40 inches (1.0 meter) tall and 88 inches (2.2 meters) wide.
2. Posters smaller than maximum size will be accepted.
3. Posters should be brief, well-organized and readable from 4 to 6 feet away
4. Posters will be viewed in the afternoon of June 9 and all day June 10.
5. Posters may be staffed on June 9 from 3:30 until 5pm if desired.
6. Boards, tape, and tacks will be provided for displaying posters.
